

EU Persistent Organic Pollutants (POP)

Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) are toxic, carbon-based chemical substances that resist natural breakdown, travel long distances through air and water, and bioaccumulate in the fatty tissues of living organisms. Within the European Union, these harmful substances are strictly controlled under the EU POPs Regulation (EU) 2019/1021, which implements the global commitments of the UN Stockholm Convention and the Aarhus Protocol.

We hereby declare that, based on the Information provided by our suppliers and on our current knowledge, the products manufactured and supplied by [Insert Company Name] do not contain substances listed in Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on Persistent Organic Pollutants, as amended and applicable at the date of this declaration.

To the best of our knowledge and based on statements from our upstream supply chain, our raw materials and manufacturing processes:

- Do not intentionally utilize or add restricted POP substances.
- Comply fully with the strict prohibitions and concentration limits outlined in **Annex I and Annex II** of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (including amendments for substances such as PFOA, PFOS, SCCPs, etc.)
